

Questions you could ask our volunteers about the animals...

- What is this animal's name?
- What type of animal is it?
- Where do you find them in Australia?
- What does it eat?
- How often do you have to feed it?
- How old is it?
- What is its expected life-span?
- How do you look after them?
- Does it shed its skin and if so how often does it shed?
- How many babies do they have each time they give birth?
- How many times do they give birth in one year?
- Does this animal have a special story?
- Can I hold it?
- Can I take a picture of it?

Information you could look for about the plants....

- What is their common name?
- What is their botanical name?
- Where would you find them in the wild in Australia?
- How big do they grow (length, width, height)?
- Do they self seed?
- What type of soil do they grow best in?
- How often do they need watering?
- Are they useful for anything (fibre, attract bees and insects, keep pests away, shelter for birds and small animals, reduce bush fire..)

Questions you could ask about the centre...

- What is the main building at the centre made of?
- What does it mean to have solar passive architecture and how does it work?
- Is all the electricity used by the centre provided by the solar panels on the roof?
- Why are there so many water tanks on the site?
- How do the toilets work?
- What sort of things does Naragebup collect for recycling?
- Where does all the material come from to make the compost?
- What are the coffee bean sacks used for?
